Carbon Dioxide

We will ensure that the carbon footprint of the company and its employees is reduced as far as practicable and then offset through robust certified projects..

Travel

Staff travel will be minimised and the lowest carbon mode of transport used wherever possible. If feasible a meeting will be held online or by conference call instead of travelling. If a journey is avoidable it will not be made.

Energy

All PCs and equipment will be switched off when not in use. Printing will be minimised, using electronic copies of documents wherever possible.

Clear is working with the Green Homes Concierge Service to make our offices as energy efficient as possible.. What we cannot reduce, we will offset.

Waste

We will minimise was generated from our operations, and recycle / re-use as much as possible.

Water

Water use will be monitored and steps will be made to keep it as low as feasibly possible.

Training and Development

At Board level, the Chairman has specific responsibilities for environmental policy development, reporting and evaluation additionally ensuring this gets communicated to all staff within the company.

All new employees will be trained in low carbon working practices on joining the company.

Supply Chain

Products will be manufactured and distributed in a way to minimise their environmental impact and consideration will be given to the sourcing of raw materials. Where feasible, products will contain as much recycled content as possible.

We will work with suppliers to improve the environmental and social performance of the supply chain.

Continuous Monitoring and Review

Clear is committed to ensuring that the environmental impact of its operations is minimised wherever possible, and as such will ensure the environmental impact of our operations is continuously assessed:

- Ensure the company is in full compliance with all relevant statutory environmental legislation
- Measure and minimise the companies direct environmental impacts including energy and water use and the production of waste and carbon dioxide (CO₂)

- Reduce, where possible, the need for movement of both goods and people. Where movement is necessary we will ensure that detrimental environmental impact is minimised.
- Procure goods and services in a socially and environmentally responsible manner.
- Promote understanding and participation in environmental issues through education and communication.
- Provide appropriate resources and any necessary training for staff to ensure that they are able to fulfil the commitments outlined in this policy
